

STEPS TO SET UP A GOV.UK ONE LOGIN ACCOUNT

1. Go to:- <https://www.gov.uk/guidance/verify-your-identity-for-companies-house>

Verify your identity >

2. Click

Go to GOV.UK One Login

3. This takes you to gov.uk One Login page, click

Create your GOV.UK One Login

Sign in

5. Enter email address to be used for the account. It is best that this is a personal email address as it will be used for other things in the future such as applying for DBS checks and will remain with you for life.

7. Set a password for the account

We're taking you to verify your identity with GOV.UK One Login

GOV.UK will ask you some simple questions to find the best way for you to verify your identity. Depending on the answers you provide, you'll then be guided to use one of the following routes:

Route 1: Use the GOV.UK mobile phone app

This is the fastest way to verify. GOV.UK One Login allows you to download an app that scans your biometric ID.

The mobile app:

- is fast and simple
- works with any up-to-date mobile phone
- is secure - the app only communicates data, it doesn't store anything

You can delete the app when you've finished.

Route 2: Verify online without the mobile phone app

If you cannot verify using the mobile phone app, you can still verify online without it. You'll need to answer a few questions about yourself to confirm who you are.

Route 3: Verify in person

If you cannot verify using the mobile phone app or online, GOV.UK One Login will tell you how to verify in person at the Post Office.

14. Check you have one of the types of Photo ID to hand, select “Yes” and continue (photocard driving licence was used in this example)

Tell us if you have one of the following types of photo ID

This will help us find the best way for you to prove your identity.

You can use one of the following types of photo ID:

- UK photocard driving licence
- UK passport
- non-UK passport with a biometric chip
- UK biometric residence permit (BRP)
- UK biometric residence card (BRC)
- UK Frontier Worker permit (FWP)

You can use an expired BRP, BRC or FWP up to 18 months after its expiry date if you have a smartphone.

15. Confirm type of device currently being used (computer in this example)

If your photo ID is a UK photocard driving licence

You need an iPhone 6s or newer, or an Android phone.

If your photo ID is a passport, BRP, BRC or FWP

You need an iPhone 7 or newer, or an Android phone.

17. Scan the QR code to download the Gov.uk ID app on your mobile

Use the GOV.UK One Login app to prove your identity

The GOV.UK One Login app works by matching your face to your photo ID.

First you will need to download, open and use the app. Then you will come back to this page to finish proving your identity.

1. Download the GOV.UK One Login app

You can download the GOV.UK One Login app by using the camera on your phone to scan the QR code.

2. Open the GOV.UK One Login app

Follow the instructions in the app to prove your identity.

18. Once app is downloaded, open it and sign in with gov.uk One Login just created
“Continue to prove your identity”
Follow instructions – select type of ID (driving licence in example), take photo of ID as instructed, then take selfie as instructed
Final screen on the app says “Return to Gov.UK on your computer or tablet”
You will note that Step 2 on the webpage automatically updates to “Completed” at this point.

2. Open the GOV.UK One Login app

Follow the instructions in the app to prove your identity.

20. The next screen gives consent for the details to be checked against the relevant government database.

We need to check your driving licence details

We need to check the details you provided on your driving licence with the DVLA.

Allow DVLA to check your driving licence details

DVLA needs your consent to check your driving licence details before you can continue. They will make sure your licence has not been cancelled or reported as lost or stolen.



What you'll need your Companies House personal code for

You'll need your personal code for various reasons. For example:

- as part of some company filings, such as the [confirmation statement \(opens in new tab\)](#)
- if you are appointed as a director
- if you become a [person with significant control \(PSC\) \(opens in new tab\)](#)

NOTE: The Companies House personal code can be accessed at a later date by logging in to Companies House website with the Gov.UK One Login and going to "Manage Account".
